Would you like to be the recipient of a \$1,000 bursary?

This award is named in honour of Cantor's Quality Meats. Edward Cantor started the small butcher shop and his sons Joe and Oscar became the lifeblood behind Cantor's Quality Meats and Groceries since their father's death in 1944 when they took over the store. Moving the store to its current location, Joe soon found himself working 12 to 16 hour days, 7 days a week. After a short while, this was cut back to the store not being open on Sunday's so the brothers could spend time with their families. Today, Joe's son Edward manages the business and has since expanded the store to its current size, making it a fully operational grocery store.

Background:

Through a donation received by Cantor's Quality Meats and matched fund by the Manitoba Métis Federation, the Louis Riel Institute is proud to offer the Red River Métis & Cantor's Family Award. This award is for Red River Métis students who are enrolled in programs such as butcher/abattoir, culinary arts or any agricultural Diploma or Certificate programs that focus on the study of livestock and processes used for the purpose of feeding people or entrepreneurs who one day want to open their own butcher shop/grocery store or run their own farm.

Application Criteria:

- Must be a registered Manitoba Métis Federation Métis Citizen.
- Post-Secondary students enrolled in butcher/abattoir, culinary arts or any agricultural programs which focus on the study of livestock and processes used for the purpose of feeding people or a related field in which you can express the connection to the butcher/abattoir field.
- Post-Secondary students who attend a school in Manitoba.

Application Requirements and Checklist:

- Completed application – make sure every section is filled out. Mark “N/A” where it does not apply to you instead of leaving it blank
- Essay (500 words)
 - In your own words describe why you chose your particular program and why you feel it fits the criteria of a program designed for the purpose of feeding people. Describe what has led you to this career choice and how you plan on using your training for the future. Provide examples and stories on how you will utilize your own Metis culture to harvest.
- Three letters of recommendation (minimum of one letter required)
 - A Métis Community Leader
 - Must be able to speak about you as a Métis community member, your relationship and interactions within the Red River Métis Community.
 - An Academic Administrator (Advisor, Counsellor, and/or Instructor),
 - Must be able to speak about your relationship and provide examples of interactions within the academic environment.
 - A Professional in the field of butcher/abattoir
 - Must be able to speak about your relationship, and provide examples of interactions.
- Proof that you are a Registered Manitoba Métis Federation Métis Citizen (see below for requirements)
- Copy of acceptance letter from a Post-Secondary Institution within the current academic year.

The following methods are acceptable ways of verifying that you are Registered Métis Citizen:

1. You are a Registered Citizen of the Manitoba Métis Federation. (Attach a pdf copy of your MMF Citizenship card)
2. You are in the process of becoming a Registered Métis Citizen with the Manitoba Métis Federation. (Attach a letter from Central Registry Office indicating you are in the process)
