Director – Louis Riel Vocational College

The Director of the Louis Riel Vocational College (LRVC) is accountable to the Senior Director and is jointly responsible for the leadership and management of the college and their Board of Directors. The Director is responsible for the operations, administration and oversees the financial management of the LRVC and provides leadership to both home office and sub offices. The Director works closely with college staff and various departments within the LRI and MMF organization, as well as acts a liaison between outside organizations.

- Knowledge of Red River Métis history and culture, and LRI programs and services is an asset
